(H)ERE lies interred the body of <b>MARGARET SCRIMSHIRE</b> spinster who died ye 15 (th May) 1748 aged 67  This grave cover was found incorporated within the slab floor of the chancel, during the restoration work after the fire. The inscription was recorded and it was then removed to its present position outside the Church in 1996/97.
